Nominated Individual

Held by: Dr Nichola Stefanou

The CQC Nominated Individual is responsible for managing the carrying on of the regulated activity (they must be in a position to speak authoritatively, on behalf of the organisation, about the way that the regulated activity is provided and direct changes and improvements to ensure compliance).

Caldicott Guardian

Held by: Rachael Byrne, Executive Director of New Models of Care

The Caldicott Guardian is a role that requires a senior person with sufficient experience and seniority to represent and champion confidentiality issues at board level and throughout the organisation's governance framework, including the governance of information management and technology.

Senior Information Risk Owner (SIRO)

Held by: John Hudson, Chief Financial Officer

The Senior Information Risk Owner (SIRO) is a board level executive with particular responsibility for information risk. They have responsibility for understanding how the strategic business goals of the organisation may be impacted by any information risks and for taking steps to mitigate those risks.

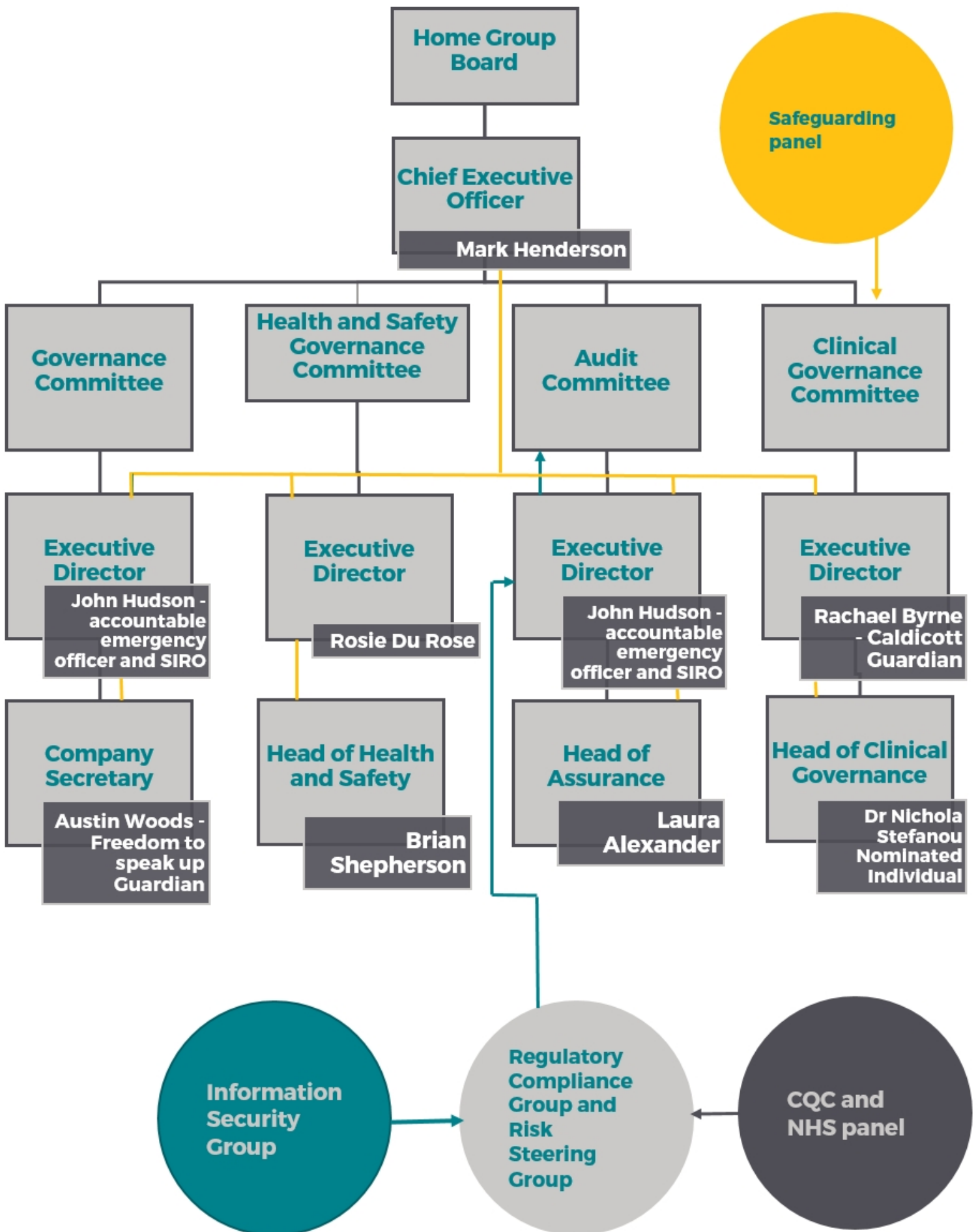
Freedom to Speak Up Guardian
